This year, we'll be exploring three of the big festivals in the Old Testament

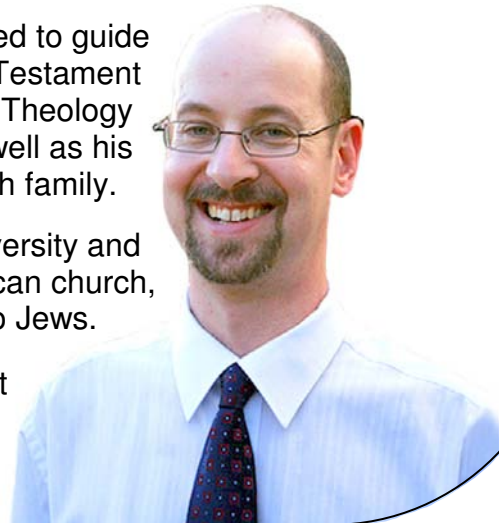
– The Passover, The Day of Atonement & The Feast of Purim –
